

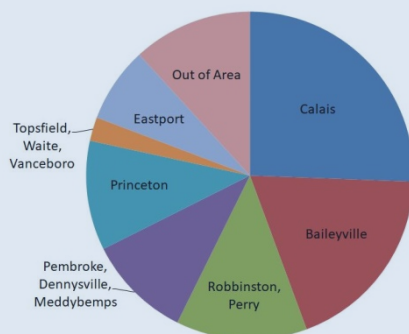
# Calais Regional Hospital – By the Numbers

CRMS encompasses the practices of surgery, orthopedics, podiatry, family practice, internal medicine & pediatrics.

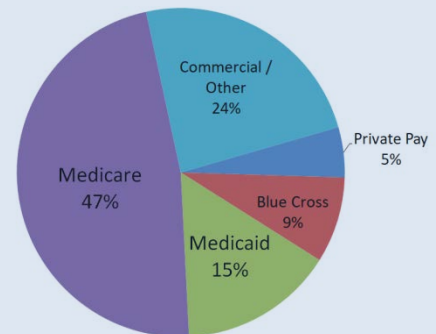

Every year Calais Regional Hospital provides vital health care services to thousands of people across the region. However the importance of CRH to the community extends far beyond healthcare.

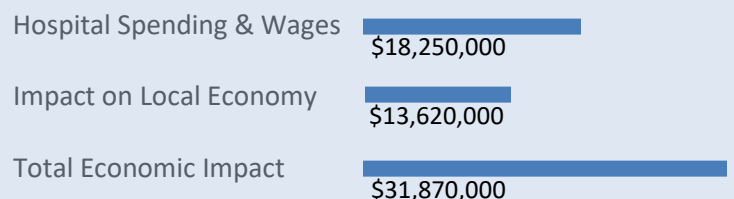
### CRH Employment Impact
